# National Advanced Youth Leadership Experience

*NAYLE will provide youth with a Philmont-based wilderness encounter that motivates them to follow a life of helping others succeed based on the values expressed in the Scout Oath and Law.*

## What is NAYLE?

National Advanced Youth Leadership Experience (NAYLE) is an exciting program of the Philmont Training Center where young men and women enhance their leadership skills in the Philmont Backcountry.

Youth will expand upon the team building and ethical decision making skills learned in National Youth Leadership Training (NYLT). NAYLE uses elements of the Philmont Ranger Training as well as advanced Search and Rescue skills to teach leadership, teamwork and the lessons of selfless service. NAYLE offers participants an unforgettable backcountry wilderness experience that develops leadership and teamwork skills, using the core elements of NYLT to make these skills intuitive.

## What Can I Expect?

The Philmont leadership is committed to making NAYLE a very special experience. You will live in a team setting at Rocky Mountain Scout Camp, a setting that forces participants to use their leadership skills to resolve challenging backcountry situations. The week will conclude with a closing challenge for each participant to build upon the legacy of Waite Phillips, the benefactor of Philmont Scout Ranch.

## What Will I Take Home from NAYLE?

- The skill, ability, and motivation to be a dynamic and effective leader taught through advanced, practical applications of NYLT skills.
- Innovative techniques to deliver NYLT skills to troops, crews, and council staffs
- Nationwide resources including new ideas and contacts that can only be gained through Philmont's unique environment
- Personal written commitment (sent to the council) to apply

## How Has the Mission Changed?

NYLT now provides the content needed for councils to develop high performing youth training teams. As such, the "train the trainer" elements are now provided to the entire NYLT staff by their council rather than the select few who attended the old NJLIC program. NAYLE still provides valuable training ideas; all the excitement, motivation, spirit and enthusiasm remains, with even greater life long leadership skills included.

## Who Can Come?

Boy Scouts must be between the ages of 14, and not yet 18, hold a troop leadership position and have completed either NYLT. Venturing members between the ages of 14, and not yet 21, must have completed NYLT or the bridging training course. Councils may send a council contingent, or units may send their Leadership Council. Concurrent adult training will be available most weeks at Philmont for council contingent leaders.

## Where and When is it?

Sessions will be at the Philmont Training Center's Rocky Mountain Scout Camp. The 2010 program will be offered June 13-19, June 20-26, June 27-July 3, July 4-10, July 11-17, July 18-24, July 25-31 and August 1-7, 2010. The cost for the program is \$355.
