

Northeast Region Youth Staff Development Course 2010 YSDC Registration Information



Purpose:

The focus of this program is on inspiring and enabling participants to deliver effective, world class National Youth Leadership Training courses in their local councils with special emphasis on improving presentation skills, evaluation skills, and on learning in more depth the NYLT leadership skills.

Program:

While attending YSDC, you will be engaged in a full program with a wide variety of activities including:

- Understanding, using, and evaluating your use of the NYLT Leadership Tools
- Making presentations on various topics (you will make 5 presentations)
- Learning how to prepare for and effectively evaluate a presentation
- Participating in effective model NYLT activities such as realistic first aid, geocache, instructional campfires, instructional inter-faith worship services, and use of the DVD
- Living and learning about the concepts of “Be, Know, Do” and “Servant Leadership”

Participant Qualifications:

This course is for Boy Scouts who meet the following qualifications:

- Have completed your council National Youth Leader Training (NYLT or JLTC). If your council does not have a youth leader training program, you may still qualify by working with a council representative to become familiar with the NYLT Staff Guide
- Have served or have been recommended to serve on the staff of a local council NYLT
- First Class rank or above
- Fourteen years of age by the opening day of course, but not yet 18
- Willingness to take back to your council NYLT the knowledge and skills acquired at YSDC

Fees: The course fee will be \$250 per participant.

Physical Conditioning

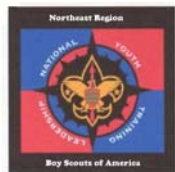
You will be engaged in strenuous physical activities and you should be in top physical condition to get the most from this program. You will need a complete physical that has been performed within a year of the last day of the course. A Health and Medical Form will be available at http://scouting.org/filestore/pdf/34605_Letter.pdf . *You cannot participate without a physician-signed Medical Form. Do **NOT** mail completed medical forms to the regional office. They are to be brought to the course by the participant and turned in on arrival.*

Camp and Camp Living

The YSDC program will be conducted at Yard’s Creek Scout Reservation off Interstate 80 near the Delaware River Gap. You will sleep in large two-person wall tents with wooden floors and cots. Bring your own sleeping bag, bedding, and sleeping pad. Showers and other facilities will be available.

Uniform

The official Boy Scout summer uniform is required with the insignia that you normally wear. The activity uniform, worn during the afternoon on most days, consists of YSDC cap and YSDC T-shirt (furnished by the course), Scout shorts, Scout socks, and Scout belt. You will not wear street clothes during the course, and you should report to the course in a complete field uniform.
